

Park Life Privacy Notice

Who is collecting and using your personal data?

Park Life will act as a “data controller” for any personal data that you provide to us. As such, we will ensure that the data give us is processed in line with your rights under the EU General Data Protection Regulations.

Why are we processing your personal data?

Park Life is processing your personal data to help us communicate with you about volunteering opportunities and news that might interest you. The lawful grounds we rely upon for processing your personal data is outlined in Article 4(1)(f) of the General Data Protection Regulation.

Who we will share your personal data with?

We will not share your personal data with other organisations without a legitimate lawful reason to do so.

How long will we hold your personal data?

Park Life will retain your personal data for 2 years.

Exercising your rights

Under the Data Protection Act 2018 and the EU General Data Protection Regulations you have the following rights;

- The right of access to your own personal data
- The right to request rectification or deletion of your personal data
- The right to object to the processing of your personal data
- The right to request a copy of the information you provide us in machine readable format
- The right to withdraw your consent to any processing that is solely reliant upon your consent
